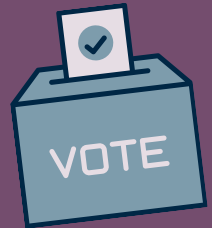

VOTER REGISTRATION

Voter Registration is open to all Weber County residents that are:

- Citizens of the United States
- Residents of Utah for at least 30 days prior to Election Day
- Be at least 18 years of age on or before the day of the General Election

16–17-year-olds may pre-register to vote and will automatically be sent a ballot when they officially become eligible to vote.

Utah is a same day voter registration state, voters may register at a vote center on election day and vote provisionally.



ELECTIONS

The Weber County Elections' Office:

- Creates the ballot for each election cycle
- Ensures that the ballot is mailed to all active and eligible voters
- Processes the ballots as they are returned
- Maintains election security and integrity through chain of custody and controls
- Hires and trains seasonal staff for in-office processing and vote centers
- Maintains and secures all election related equipment
- Maintains the voter registration database
- Maintains electronic poll books



INFORMATION REQUEST

You may request a list of registered voters within Weber County. The following information is provided per Utah State law:

- Voter Name
- Voter ID
- Precinct
- Age
- Residence Address
- Date of Registration
- Mailing Address
- Party Affiliation
- Vote History (if you participated in an election, not how you voted)

SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES – VOTED REPORT

- Beginning the week ballots are mailed up until the Friday before Election Day, you may request to receive a report listing all voters who have returned their ballots. You may receive a Voted Report daily or weekly. Forms to request information and fee schedules are available on our website.
