



VOTER RESPONSIBILITY

You as the voter play a vital role in election security.

Your responsibilities include:

- Keep your registration current at vote.utah.gov.
- Sign up at ballottrax.utah.gov to be notified when your ballot is mailed, received by the county, and counted.
- Enroll in the post office's Informed Delivery service to be notified on the very day your ballot arrives.
- Utah law prohibits ballot harvesting – protect your ballot and don't entrust it to anyone else.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Before approving any voter registration, county staff verify ID.

- Citizens must provide either:
 - Driver's License Number/State ID
 - the last four digits of their Social Security Number.
- Accuracy of Voter Rolls are maintained daily through:
 - State's Death Records
 - Obituaries
 - Driver's License Records
 - Post Office Records
 - ERIC Database

AUDIT

The Lt. Governor's Office audits the statewide voter registration database.

BALLOT PROCESSING

- Envelope Controls:
 - Each voter's envelope is assigned a unique number, to ensure they can only vote once.
- Weber County maintains a strong chain of custody over ballots:
 - All ballot processing is open to the public and is performed by at least two sworn, trained election judges.
 - Ballots are carefully processed in numbered batches and reconciled from start to finish.

AUDIT

Multiple audits are performed in full public view before, during, and after every election.

VOTING EQUIPMENT, BALLOT SCANNERS, AND TABULATION

- Equipment Certification:
 - Election equipment has been certified by the United States Election Assistance Commission (EAC).
 - Software updates are also EAC certified.
- No internet connection:
 - Ballot scanners and tabulators are never connected to the internet.
 - Any software updates are performed manually under county supervision.

AUDIT

Every machine is audited at least twice each election, in a formal public meeting.
